Roller blinds come in a variety of fabrics and bottom bars and are a popular choice. Most roller blinds have a chain control to raise and lower the blind. Our roller blinds come with child safety features to minimize the risk of strangulation. Our roller blinds have the option of being remote controlled, which eliminates the chain controls and creates a child safe blinds.

Sunscreen roller blinds feature a technical woven fabric that reduces the sun's glare and cuts infrared and UV light, whilst still allowing a view out. They are ideal for bi-fold or sliding doors in kitchen/dining areas and especially for south facing windows. They cut reflections on computer screens, protect furniture and artwork from fading, and keep rooms cool.

Blackout roller blinds are ideal for home cinemas and bedrooms where blocking the light is essential. For light sleepers and shift workers, blackout roller blinds can make a huge difference to sleep. They can also be used behind curtains and other roller blinds.

Thermal roller blinds are made using a high performance fabric that keeps the heat in, reducing heating bills and your carbon footprint. The fabric has metallic fibres woven within it which effectively reflects heat back into the room.

Venetian blinds are made with wood or metal slats that can be tilted, raised or lowered to control the light that is let into the room. Our wood venetian blinds are bespoke and individually made to your measurements and colour choice.

Roman blinds come in a variety of fabrics and can create a luxurious hotel feel. They create a soft, drapery effect and are the modern alternative to curtains.

Vertical blinds have vertical vanes which can be tilted or drawn open to control the light. They are ideal for large windows and bifold doors as the vanes compact easily and neatly to provide minimum obstruction and maximum view. Our vertical blinds come in a range of fabrics including blackout, thermal.

Bottom up blinds roll up from the bottom of the window using a tensioned pulley system. They are ideal for windows at street level or bathroom windows where privacy is required without blocking the light. All our roller blinds are available as bottom up blinds.
